

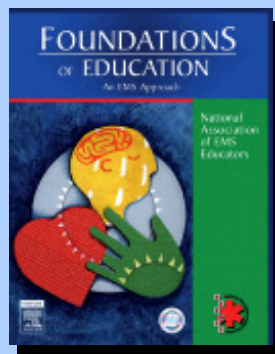
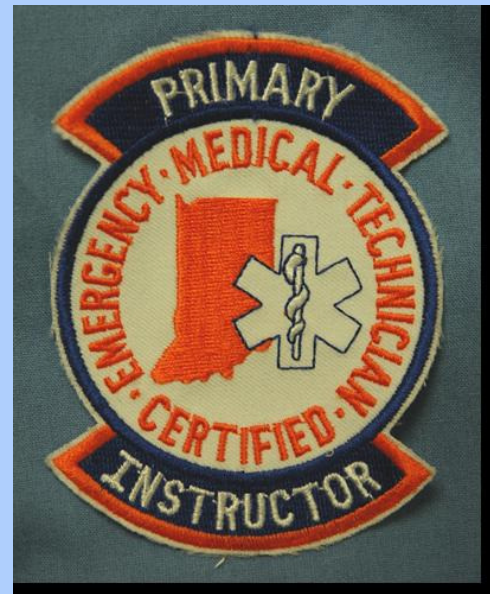
RECORDS - PRIMARY
